

Spring/Fall Cleanup and Bulk/Large Item Pickup Guidelines

Cleanups are for Comstock Township residents only and cleanup collection will not include commercial or apartment buildings.

Household doors and windows, furniture, mattresses, and carpeting will be accepted:

Carpeting must be rolled and securely tied in no longer than four (4) foot sections for it to be collected.

Mattresses/Boxsprings should be wrapped in plastic.

Bags placed for collection may not exceed thirty-five (35) pounds and cans may not exceed seventy-five (75) pounds.

No individual item over five (5) feet in length, three (3) feet wide or (3) three feet high or weighing over 100 pounds.

Windows, glass, and mirrors must be less than 3'x4' in size. Broken glass should be placed in a box, taped shut, and clearly marked, "Broken Glass."

All small items must be in bags or cans for collection. LOOSE PILES WILL BE LEFT FOR THE HOMEOWNERS DISPOSAL.

Waste Management will not accept:

- Auto parts, engines, tires, batteries
- Electronics, including televisions, computers, printers, fax machines
- Lumber, plaster, drywall, paneling, siding, or other building materials
- Chemicals, pesticides, paints, solvents or other household hazardous waste
- Propane tanks/gas tanks
- Ashes
- Dead Animals
- Fencing
- Concrete, dirt, rocks, sod, or stumps
- Iron or steel,
- Cast iron bathtubs, or
- Medical waste

These items will not be collected and will be left for the homeowner's disposal. Absolutely no loose lumber or building materials will be collected.

Waste Management will not accept appliances that contain Freon, which include air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, and dehumidifiers, unless the appliance bears a certification sticker indicating that the Freon has been removed by a certified technician.
